PEACE DOVES

Peace Doves is a mass-participation artwork by Peter Walker, made up of thousands of paper doves, each bearing a handwritten message of peace hope and love.

Throughout the summer visitors to Lincoln Cathedral, schools and community groups, have been writing their messages of peace on the doves which have now been curated by Peter Walker to create a stunning installation of a flock of more than 10,000 doves floating above the nave.

The artwork is set to music by composer David Harper, and is illuminated to create a beautiful and inspiring atmosphere in which to contemplate the meaning of peace in our own lives and communities, and across the world.

Events marked with a dove take place beneath the Peace Doves, giving them a unique atmosphere and setting.
